



**POSITION TITLE:** Professor of Psychology and Program Director of B.A. Psychology

**SUPERVISOR:** Vice President of Academic Affairs

**DESCRIPTION:**

The successful candidate for this faculty position will assume responsibility as a full-time faculty member teaching primarily in the B.A. Psychology Program and for oversight of that program. Additionally, the candidate will be required to manage the final stages of closure of the M.A. Counseling Program. The position begins as soon as available.

**SCHEDULE:** Teach 21 credit hours per year primarily in undergraduate Psychology

**SALARY:** Rank and salary determined by experience and qualifications; stipend for program direction, and full-time benefits included

**PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Teach 21 credit hours per year primarily in undergraduate Psychology
- Provide clinical supervision for undergraduate Psychology students
- Maintain specified office hours and be available for additional student mentoring and advising
- Attend chapels (weekly) and commencement exercises (annually)
- Participate in faculty meetings, workshops, and committees
- B.A. Psychology Program direction including:
  - Program planning and assessment
  - Engagement and oversight of the success of students in the program
  - Working with Academic Affairs personnel in the scheduling, conduct, and evaluation of courses within the program
  - Work with a variety of Criswell College departments to ensure program vitality
  - Cultivate working relationships with individuals within and external to the College to consistently provide resources for the program
  - Serve as a standing member of the Academic Cabinet
