- 1. **Summary:** This policy establishes the permissible recording and use of classroom lectures by students.
- **2. Rationale:** This policy is necessary to ensure the proper recording and use of classroom lectures and presentations.
- 3. Entities Affected: students
- 4. **Definitions:** not applicable
- **5. Policy:** Students are permitted to record classroom lectures and other class presentations in a course only with prior permission from the course instructor. Students must request permission to record at the beginning of the semester in which the course is offered. Students are forbidden from using recordings of lectures or class presentations for publication or other means of reproduction. Recordings are for individual student use only.
- 6. Procedure:
  - a. Implementation: not applicable
